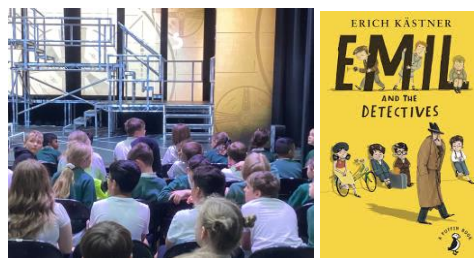
End of Theme 4 Class Visits
