KS2 CHRISTMAS SHOW



As you will be aware, all the children in KS2 are busy rehearsing their all-singing, all-dancing performances of 'songs from the musicals' ready to create a special film (recorded by school staff) to share with families during the last week of term.

At Cale Green we are determined that the children get the opportunity to perform to the highest standards they can and experience performing to a live audience within the safety guidance we are following. With this in mind, each class will perform their routine to children in another phase in addition to filming.

To ensure the children are performance-ready, we would like all children to come to school dressed in a costume on **Thursday 16th December**. Further information about what your child will need to wear is detailed below. There should be no need to buy anything new!

Hawthorn	Hakuna Matata – Lion King	Black / brown trousers / leggings Plain T shirt in a shade of red, orange, yellow Crown – made in school (Optional) Lion tail made from old pair of tights
Jasmine	Raindrops Keep Fallin' on My Head	Wellies (if available) Umbrella
Juniper	Sparkle and Shine - Nativity	Anything sparkly! Boys – shirt and school trousers / trousers (no logos please) Girls – party clothes!

All the songs and backing tracks have now been uploaded to the children's class pages so they can easily practise at home. Please encourage them to learn the songs without using the words as soon as they can.

Finally, our intention is to upload the completed film for families to enjoy in the class pages within the school website during the last week of term. Whilst we cannot guarantee the film does not find its way into the public domain, we know the security systems and the restrictions around access to our website that are in place ensure higher levels of privacy for children and families than other sharing platforms.

We will require permission from families to film the children and share the recording in this way. A consent form can be found on School Spider. We would appreciate this being signed by the end of the week.
